COURSE DESCRIPTION

Families, caregivers, and long-term-care professionals underestimate the abilities of individuals in mid-stage and late-stage dementia. Many feel that the ability to remain continent, dress and feed themselves, and engage in leisure and recreational skills is no longer possible.

This course will provide a practical approach to dementia with practical examples of how to maintain these skills, deal with problem behaviors, and challenge these individuals to live a full life... one filled with joy!

COURSE OBJECTIVES

At the conclusion of this course, the participant will be able to:

1. List characteristics of individuals in Stages 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7 provided by the Global Deterioration Scale and the behaviors found in each stage of dementia.
2. Identify which of the 7 Stages found in the Global Deterioration Scale in which an individual falls, and predict what functional abilities are still possible in the areas of Self-Care, ambulation, and toileting when given a list of physical behaviors an individual with dementia exhibits.
3. Identify new alternatives to bowel and bladder incontinence and be able to list 5 strategies to decrease bowel and bladder incontinence.
4. Stage the individual using the adapted fast, and write 3 short-term, and long-term goals for this level of dementia using Medicare guidelines when given a video of an individual with dementia.

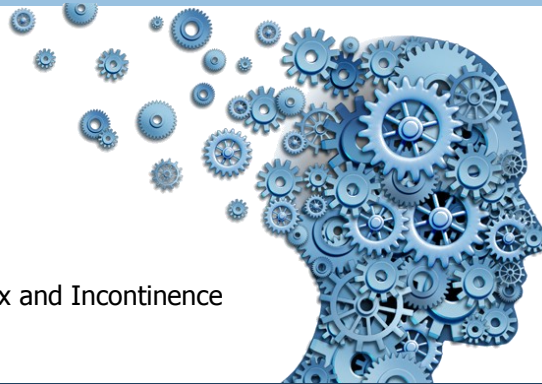
