COURSE DESCRIPTION

A **FedEx Day**, originally created in 2004 by Atlassian, an Australian IT solutions company, is a 24-hour event in which employees deliver innovation to the company they work for. It is called **FedEx Day**, because you have to deliver overnight, like the parcel delivery company. A **FedEx Day** is a fixed time box in which people are not disturbed for regular work. Within this time box, employees have total autonomy over the project they are enthusiastic about. They decide for themselves what they will be working on, who they are going to work with, and how they are going to do it. Only one rule applies, show the results to the company. The concept has turned highly successful and was presented to the world at large with now spreading to many Fortune 10 companies adopting this technique.

QTC has launched their own version of FEDEX day. QTC started FEDEX days earlier this year. Our Director of Operations, Enza Levy, has lead the innovation blitz by trading positions for a day with a QTC SLP, Enza treats the SLP's patients for a day, while that SLP spends the day out of the facility working on anything they want!

The outcomes of this QTC therapy hack need to be shared because they are AWESOME!
